- (c) the action taken/being taken by Government in this regard?

(a), (b) & (c): 'Public Order' and 'Police' are State subjects as per the Seventh Schedule to the Constitution of India. Hence prevention, detection, registration, investigation and prosecution of offences are primarily the concerns of the State Governments/UT Administrations.
